How to Apply

- 1** Verify that the equipment qualifies for a rebate by consulting with a licensed contractor and reviewing the qualification table on the back of this page.
- 2** Purchase the qualified equipment and have a licensed contractor install it. Have the licensed contractor sign this application when the work is completed.
- 3** Obtain an invoice from your contractor containing the following information: quantity installed, equipment manufacturer, model numbers, size in tons, date and location of installation, total installation costs, contractor's name and address, and an indication of "paid in full" or "zero balance".
- 4** Complete this application. Attach a copy of your invoice and the equipment's AHRI Certificate to this application. Mail, or scan and email, these documents to the Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources (details on back). After your application is processed, you will receive your rebate check in the mail within 4 to 6 weeks.

Air Conditioning Rebate Application (pg 1)

The Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources (OER) is offering mail-in rebates for energy efficient air conditioning systems installed on Block Island. Only Block Island homeowners and businesses may apply. A licensed contractor must install the system and sign this 2-page application. Only qualifying equipment models are eligible. See qualifying equipment and rebate amounts below.
